



Information for all drivers

We are looking forward to welcoming you on site for Gilwell 24. To make your arrival and departure as smooth as possible, please read through the information below.

For Health and Safety reasons we discourage people from arriving before 2pm on Friday – however, you can set up your camp the day before (up to 8pm on Thursday evening).

What to expect...

The activities start at 9pm on Friday, and 9am on the Saturday morning however, traffic management will be in operation some time before then. The site may appear chaotic and therefore it is important that you follow all directions from our Traffic Management Team.

Routes

Gilwell Park is situated approximately 5 minutes from Chingford and 10 minutes from the M25 (J26).

However, there is a specific route that **MUST** be followed as access to Gilwell Park will **NOT** be possible from Daws Hill. The revised route therefore is shown on the map.

Low Emission Zone

From 3 January 2012, Transport for London have announced that some minibuses, large vans and other vehicles will now be impacted by the Low Emission Zone (LEZ). As Gilwell Park is on the boundary of the zone, it is likely some visitors will enter the zone, therefore all drivers should review information at <https://tfl.gov.uk/modes/driving/low-emission-zone?cid=pp024>

Arrivals and parking

To ensure the safety of all the people on site and to ensure that all spaces are available for activities, we have to limit the movement of vehicles around the site. To achieve this we have to implement the system below.

A shuttle bus will operate between the off-site car parks and the main site. This will be running continuously on Friday evening, early Saturday morning and Sunday morning then on demand at all other times.

As there is limited space on site, please consider how you can reduce the number of vehicles you bring, e.g. by car sharing and by not bringing unnecessary equipment with you. However, we have arranged for off-site parking to be available and all vehicles will be parked at this location. This is a short walk or minibus shuttle back to the main site. The shuttle bus will operate from the shuttle bus stop and this is marked on the event map.



On arrival you will be directed through a one-way system. There will be clearly signed routes for:

- People dropping off young people and then making their way off site – maximum stay 15 minutes.
- People who do not require a kit run and will park vehicles and transport camping kit to site by hand/trolleys (Please note there may be a significant walk from the vehicle to the campsite, so please pack your vehicle accordingly. We recommend big combined bags). You will then be required to move your vehicle off-site after unloading.
- People who require a kit run - this involves unloading your camping kit onto one of our pickup/trailers, we will deliver it to your site and ask you to move to park your vehicles offsite (Please note there may be a significant distance from the vehicle to the campsite, so please pack your vehicle accordingly. We recommend big combined bags)

Please consider carefully if you are travelling in convoy where the adults, leaders and booking reference numbers are as you will need to send a leader to registration, kit and vehicles to site and manage your young people, while we will also ask you to take your vehicles off-site. We will do our best to help you through this, but having a plan and discussing this with your young people and parents etc before you get to site can make everything a lot smoother!

The Traffic Management Team will be wearing Hi-Vis, and will do their very best to get you where you need to go. Please follow their directions and the traffic system in place. Please be patient when waiting for a kit run or parking as we will be trying our hardest to get everyone on site as quickly and as safely as possible. All vehicles (Even those just dropping off) must display a vehicle pass. **This must be completed in full.** We reserve the right to refuse entry onto site to vehicles without a pass.

Disabled parking must be reserved in advance and you must hold a blue permit to use this. Please email info@gilwell24.info should you require a disabled parking space and include your booking reference.

Please note: In certain circumstances where vehicles are causing an obstruction or are incorrectly parked, Gilwell Park reserves the right to tow such vehicles out of the way without the owner's express permission.

Collecting vehicles from Off-site Parking

Vehicles may only be collected from off-site parking when you are fully ready to leave as there is limited parking space on site. Shuttle buses will operate continuously from the shuttle bus stop on Sunday.




All groups will be allocated to a field on arrival (including early arrivals on Thursday) and fields will be opened in a phased manner. This means that if you are regular attendee of Gilwell 24 you may not be able to camp on the field you normally do, depending on your arrival time.

During arrival and departure there will be members of the Camping Space Team on all fields to aid your camp setup. The Traffic Management and Camping Space Teams will advise you on where we would like you to set up your camp, and will record your camping location so that they can inform any other members of your group that arrive at Reception.

Please note that we have special arrangements and camping locations for Explorers camping under permit (if you are not with a leader). On arrival on site please let the traffic management team know if this applies to you so that they can direct you to the right place.

Directions to Gilwell Park and offsite parking instructions



ROAD CLOSED
Gilwell Park is NOT ACCESSIBLE from Daws Hill

- Minibus Offsite Car Park 1:**
1. Turn right out of Gilwell Park towards Chingford.
 2. Follow road passing through small hamlet and then passing the edge of the forest.
 3. As you leave the forest, on the left hand side of the road you will see Chingford Plain, a large open area - our offsite parking is located here and is signposted.
- All Other Vehicles Offsite Car Park 2:**
1. Turn left out of Gilwell Park down Daws Hill.
 2. At T junction turn right.
 3. Continue on this road for 1.6 miles.
 4. At the roundabout, take the first exit left onto Meridian Way.
 5. Go straight over the next roundabout.
 6. Turn left onto Station Road.
 7. Continue down this road for 400 yards, then turn right into the Lee Valley White Water Centre.
